Grant: Fulbright / Fundação Carmona e Costa grant for Master in Fine Arts, Drawing.

Competition for this grant takes place every two years and selects one grantee.

2. Brief analysis of how the promotion, competition and selection process took place (planning, outreach, media, calendars, pool of evaluators, etc).

Competitions opened on February 1st and ended on March 31st.

On February 3, we offered a webinar for applicants to this grant and to the Fulbright Grant for Master's and PhD and the Fulbright Travel Grant that was viewed 407 times. The webinar consisted of a full explanation of the grants conditions and of the application form. We showed each and every page of the application form, highlighting the questions where applicants usually show more difficulty and describing where and how the additional documents should be uploaded.

We received 4 applications and during the application process replied to inquiries from 9 students concerning this grant. The applications and portfolios were reviewed by a panel of 3 evaluators, who selected 2 candidates for the next phase of the evaluation process – a visit to the applicants' studios. These visits were held on April 19 and only one of the applicants passed to the interview phase. The interview took place on April 27 and the evaluators recommended the selection of the candidate.
